### 12 BOTTLES OF ALEXANDER VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



Alexander Vineyard is a small, family-owned estate in the heart of the Martinborough Terrace which has an international reputation for producing outstanding Pinot Noir.

The vines are cared for under a sustainable winegrowing programme and a fruit is hand-picked before winemaking with extensive wild-yeast use. This has produced an aromatic, deeply-scented wine with dark morello and berryfruit flavours with typical savoury complexity and gentle oak notes.

Aged in French barriques, mainly Allier forest oak, for eleven months, this handcrafted and barrel selected single vineyard wine can be enjoyed now or cellared for many years.

Alexander Vineyard has received numerous accolades for their wines, with the latest being:

#### Michael Cooper's Buyers Guide to New Zealand Wines 2020

"Offering top value, the 2018 vintage (\*\*\*\*\*) was estate-grown in Martinborough, hand-picked and matured in French oak barriques (25% new). Bright ruby, it is fragrant, full-bodied and sweet-fruited with vibrant cherry, plum and spice flavours, a subtle seasoning of oak and a finely textured, very harmonious finish. It's well worth cellaring to 2023+".

The 5 star rating given denotes wine of outstanding quality (gold medal standard) and it was also nominated as a Potential NZ Classic wine. Of special note is that this wines' 'baby brother', the second label, Alexander Dusty Road Pinot Noir 2018 was named in the Buyers Guide as Best Red Wine Buy of the Year 2020.



# 'SURE TO SHINE' ARTWORK BY PHILIPPA BENTLEY

Philippa Bentley is a multi-disciplinary artist, inspired by nature, with ecology and environmental concerns at the heart of her work.

Philippa has always lived close to the sea and now spends much time on the water, too, sailing.



"We are an island nation - New Zealand begins with the sea and ends with the sea - and we all have a relationship with the water". It is not surprising that Philippa's artwork has been informed by these experiences and reflects the careful observation and love of the natural world, overlaid with a layer of contemplation.

The artist has become increasingly concerned over the global impact of environmental issues and this has been reflected in the development of her work over the last few years. Sea charts have become her symbol of navigating our way forward, plotting a course through these troubled, uncharted waters. Philippa's work frequently references natural history collections and archives, and contains an image within an image.

Philippa has two senior academic prizes from the University of Auckland but had drawn, painted and written since she could remember and ultimately committing to a career as an artist was the natural path.

Philippa has been working professionally as an artist since 2005. She has won awards in painting, printmaking and design and been a finalist in a number of New Zealand and international art awards. Her work is held in collections in New Zealand and overseas.
